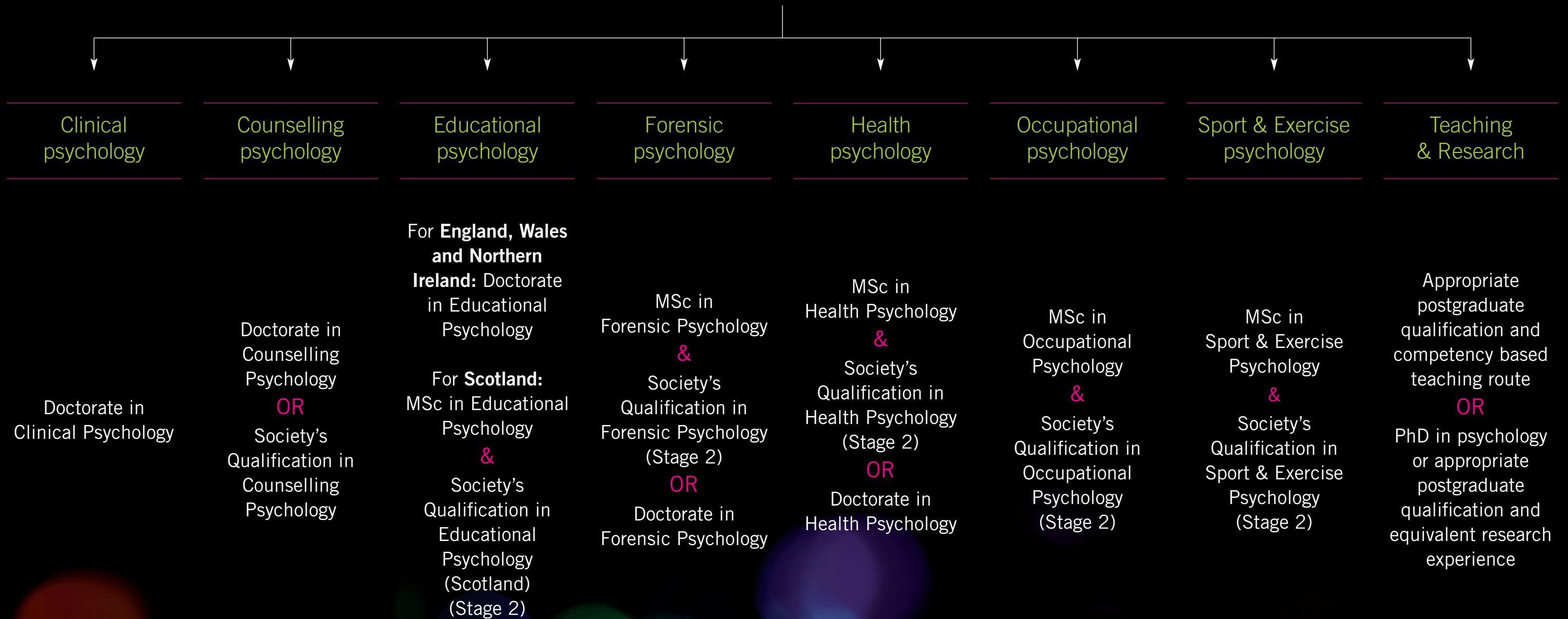


Training to become a Chartered Psychologist

Graduate Basis for Chartered Membership (GBC)

GBC is gained by completing a Society accredited undergraduate degree or conversion course.



In order to work as a Practitioner Psychologist in the UK, you would need to have completed a programme that is approved by the Health Professions Council (HPC). The HPC may approve programmes other than those accredited by the Society; these would enable you to practise but would not provide a route to Chartered Membership.
