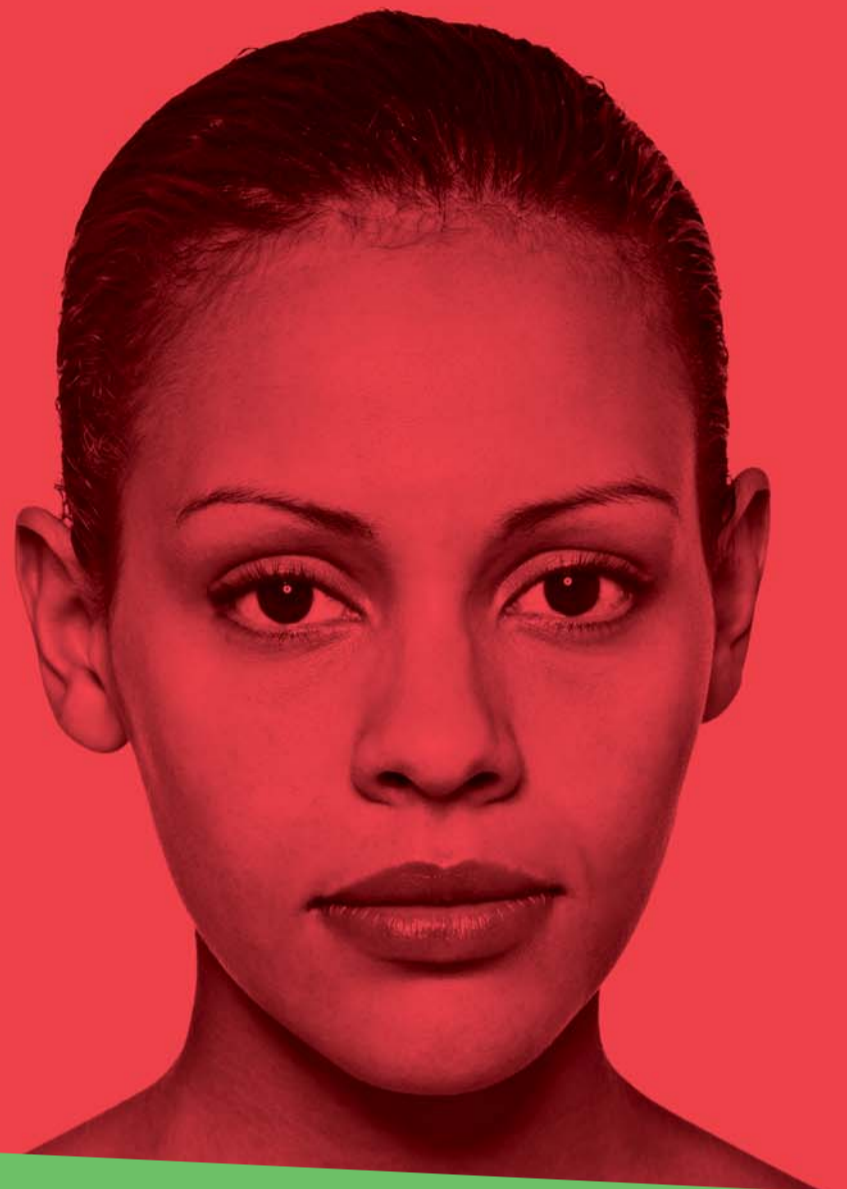


# neuropsychology

## Where do neuropsychologists work?

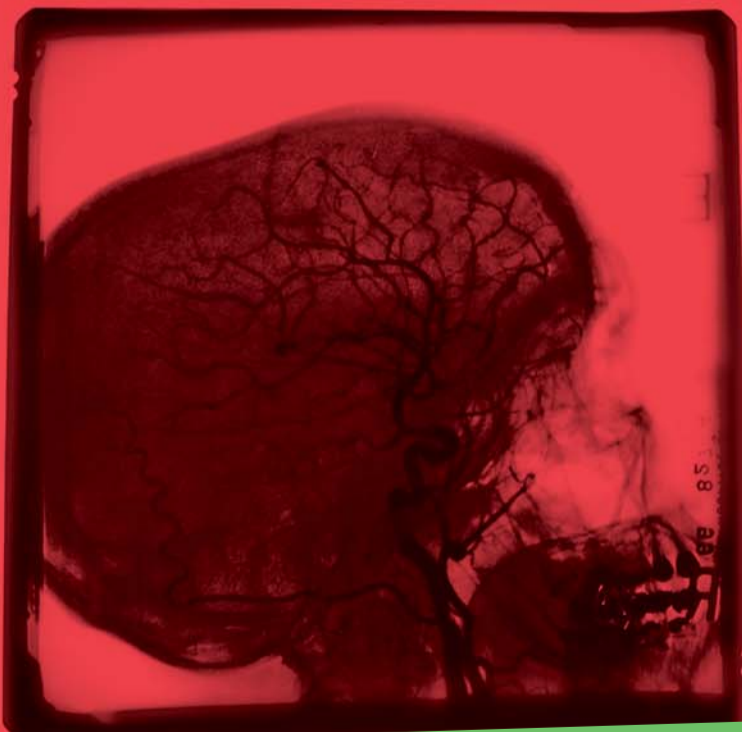
Hospital settings; rehabilitation centres; community services.

## What do they do?

Provide post-hospital assessment for people with brain injuries or neurological problems by maximising their recovery and minimising disability.

## How do you become a neuropsychologists?

Degree in psychology; postgraduate training which would qualify you for registration as a chartered psychologist (typically clinical or educational); accredited MSc in neuropsychology.
