

DHP Excellence in Health Psychology Early Career Award 2021

Overview

The Excellence in Health Psychology Early Career Award is a new award which celebrates the work of those who are in training (Stage 2 Trainees) or are qualified and within 10 years of completing Stage 1 training (MSc Health Psychology). We welcome nominations from or on behalf of trainees or recently qualified Health Psychologists who have demonstrated excellence in the discipline. The deadline for nominations is the 24th May 2021, 4pm.

Types of nominations

Nominations can be made either by yourself or on behalf of an individual who works in the area of health psychology.

Entry criteria

The Nominee:

- 1) May be an individual or a small collaborative team (e.g. for a group-based project)
- 2) Must be member of the BPS Division of Health Psychology (DHP)
- 3) Must be enrolled on a BPS accredited Qualification in Health Psychology and/or working in the area of Health Psychology
- 4) Must be within ten active years of their Master's degree in Health Psychology (Stage 1)

Please note the term "active" is intended to exclude any period of career break and is full-time equivalent.
