

Health Psychology Update – Deputy Editor/Research Sub-Editor

The Deputy Editor/Research Sub-Editor is responsible for:-

- Soliciting research articles, including original research articles, short research articles and literature reviews
- Seeking out and liaising with reviewers, sending articles out for review and supporting the review process
- Determining the appropriateness of research articles submitted
- Communicating with the co-ordinating editor and the editorial board, including attending editorial meetings as required
- Helping to publicise HPU through relevant networks or social media channels where appropriate

The Deputy Editor leads on the generation and co-ordination of research content for the publication and would work with the Editor, and other sub-editors, to help move HPU forward to ensure content of the publication is meeting expectations of both the DHP committee and membership. This is a voluntary role and is expected to be for 3 years.
