Dr Fergus Neville is a lecturer in the School of Management at the University of St Andrews. His research examines group processes, including the roles of social identities and social norms in group influence, crowd behaviour and leadership. He is currently working on how to harness group processes to facilitate the public response to COVID-19, and how crowds react to perceived hostile threats. Fergus has authored articles in outlets including the *European Journal of Social Psychology*, *PLOS ONE*, *Social Personality & Psychology Compass*, *Group Processes & Intergroup Relations* and *the Journal of Community and Applied Psychology* and has received funding from research bodies including the *ESRC* and *Home Office*.

Fergus has been a committee member since 2018, and is currently co-author of the monthly newsletter.
