Dr Mhairi Bowe is a Senior Lecturer in Social and Community Psychology at Nottingham Trent University. Mhairi's research focuses on collective and place identities and how they link with health, well-being, and social processes, such as continuity, transition and marginalisation. Mhairi has published in journals such as *European Journal of Social Psychology*, *British Journal of Social Psychology*, *BMJ Open*, and the *Journal of Health Psychology* and has been funded by the ESRC and NHS.

Mhairi is Associate Lead of the [Groups, Identities, and Health](#) Research Group at NTU and her work is currently focused on social prescribing and community volunteering in relation to poverty, belonging, stigma, and COVID-19.
